

# Kaddish

The **חֲצִי קַדִּישׁ** , (half Kaddish) is recited in many congregations as a section marker, separating different parts of the service. The spaces in the board below are divided into sections. The spaces on the left contain various Aramaic words from **קַדִּישׁ**. Each word in Aramaic has a matching word in Hebrew and in English. Take a box of crayons. Use a different color to color in each sequence of three matching words - Aramaic, Hebrew, and English.

The board consists of three main groups of hexagonal tiles:

- Group 1 (Left):** Aramaic words with numbers 1-7.
  - 1: שְׁמָה
  - 2: וְאִמְרוּ
  - 3: מְבָרַךְ
  - 4: לְעֵלָם
  - 5: דְּקַדְשָׁא
  - 6: יְהֵא
  - 7: רַבָּא
- Group 2 (Top-Right):** English words with numbers 1-7.
  - 1: name
  - 2: and let us say
  - 3: praised
  - 4: forever
  - 5: holy
  - 6: may
  - 7: great
- Group 3 (Bottom-Right):** Hebrew words with numbers 1-7.
  - 1: שֵׁם
  - 2: וְנֹאמַר
  - 3: מְבָרַךְ
  - 4: לְעוֹלָם
  - 5: קָדוֹשׁ
  - 6: יְהִי
  - 7: רַב
