

Kedushah

The word **כְּבוֹד** means "glory" or "honor." Show **כְּבוֹד** by climbing towards **קְדוּשָׁה**, holiness, through good deeds and word knowledge. Choose a ladder. Start on the lowest rung. The number on the rung will lead you to a Hebrew word or phrase. Say the English meaning of the Hebrew word or phrase. Then climb up one rung for a word, two rungs for a phrase. Take turns with a partner.

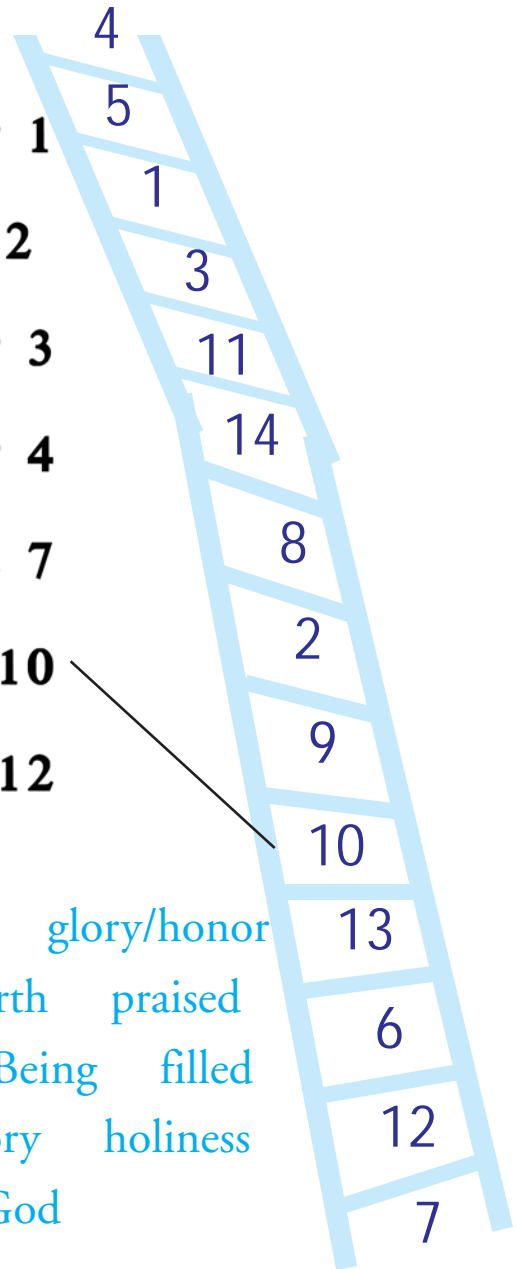

One student starts at the bottom of the blue ladder, the other at the bottom of the cyan ladder. The first rung has a 13. Student would say, "אֶרֶץ land or earth." Since אֶרֶץ is one word, he would move up one rung. If he landed on #10, he or she would say "כָּל-הָאָרֶץ - all the earth," and then move up two rungs.
