








The **הַפְּטָרָה** and **הַפְּטָרָה** blessings are generally chanted by the bar or bat mitzvah boy or girl. At many congregations, this is followed by a Dvar-Torah, or speech, about the **תּוֹרָה** and **הַפְּטָרָה** portions.
