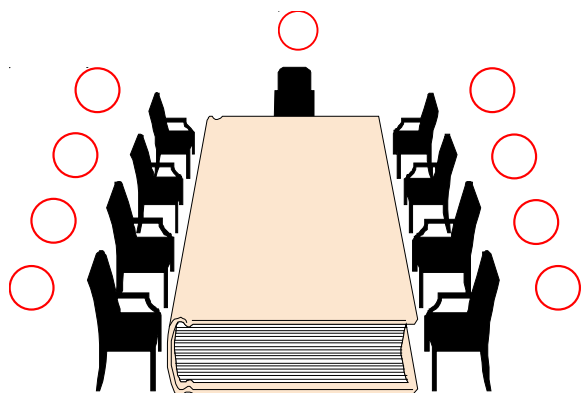


DINNER CALL

At the bottom of the page is a list of the Hebrew words you are inviting to dinner. Use the seating instructions below to put the words in the right seats. (Place the correct numbers in the circles).
(Hint: You can start on either side of the table).



SEATING INSTRUCTIONS

Day should be at the head of the table.

Evening should be between *day* and *night*.

Place *evenings* across from *night*.

Praised should be next to *day*,
and on the same side as *between*.

There should be two seats separating *between* and *day*.

There should be one seat separating *brings on (evenings)* and *night*.

Night should be near *and between*.

Seat *separates* across from *brings on (evenings)*.
