The root **שמע** appears in the **שְׁמַע** in command form:

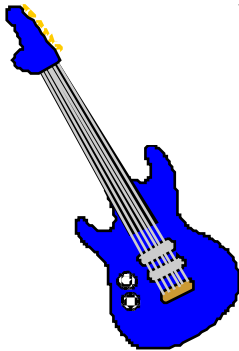
שְׁמַע - Listen, or Listen up!

Here is a table with some other forms of this root:

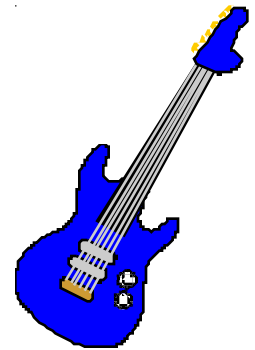

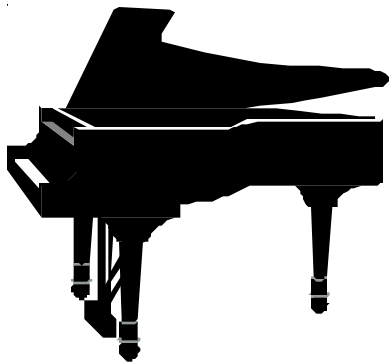
