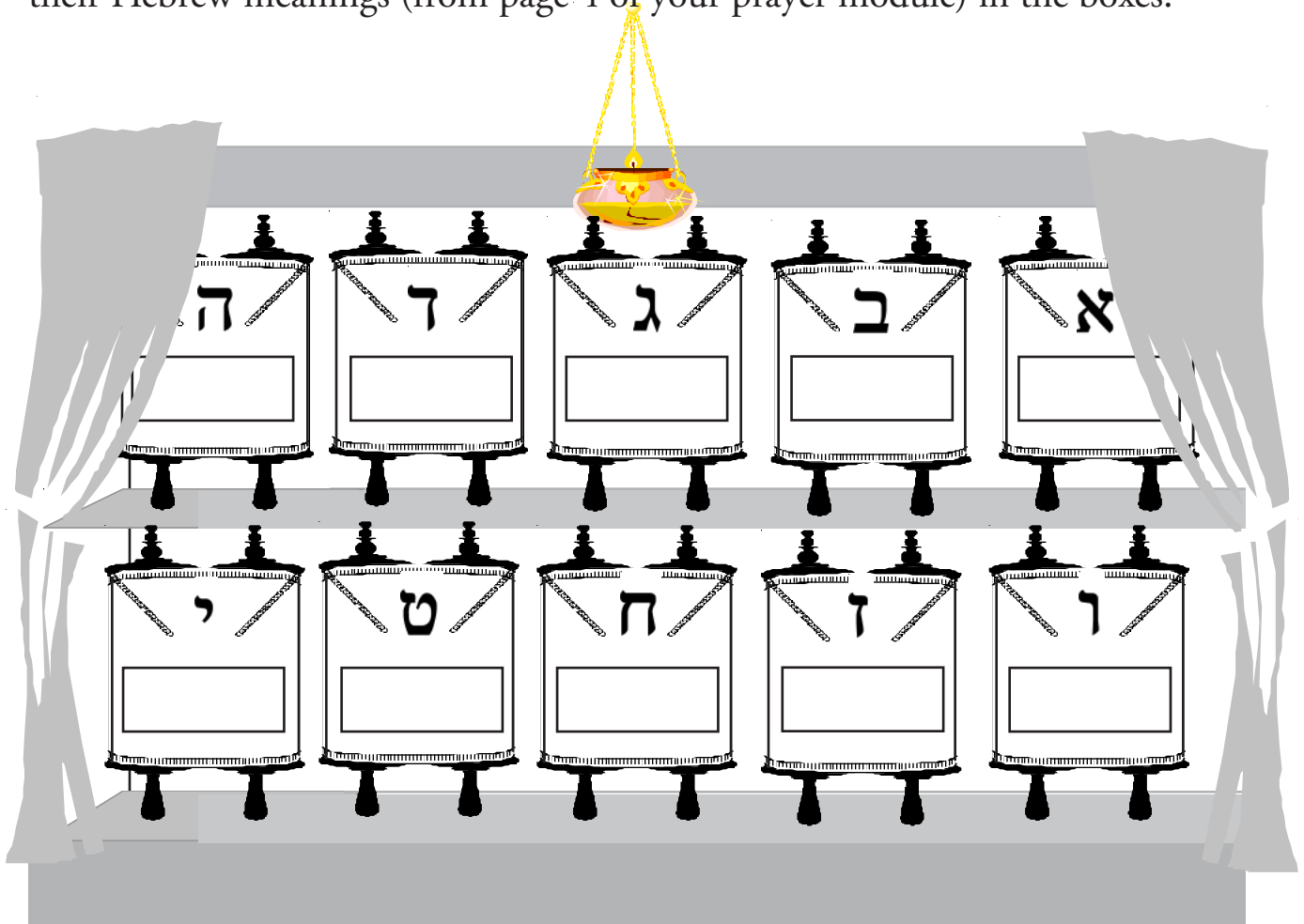


Often several **תּוֹרָה** scrolls are kept in the ark at a synagogue. Some days (for example when a festival like Succot falls on a Saturday) we read from two or even three **תּוֹרָה** scrolls. For Kol Nidre (on Yom Kippur evening), it is customary for all scrolls to be removed from the ark and held by members of the community.

The ark below contains several **תּוֹרָה** scrolls. On each **תּוֹרָה** cover you will find a Hebrew letter and an empty box. Under the ark is a list of English translations of words from **בְּרִכּוֹת הַתּוֹרָה**. Match up the letters on the Torah scrolls with the letters over the English words below, and write their Hebrew meanings (from page 4 of your prayer module) in the boxes.
