

The eighth and ninth words of the **וְאֶהְבֶּתָּ** are **וּבְכָל-מְאֹדְךָ**.

**מְאֹדְךָ** comes from **מְאֹד**, meaning "very" or "very much."

What would this phrase mean? **טוֹב מְאֹד** \_\_\_\_\_

In the **וְאֶהְבֶּתָּ**, **מְאֹד** is usually translated "strength" or "might."

**וּבְכָל-מְאֹדְךָ** = with all your strength.
